

How to check for water leaks at home



Indoors

- Listen for dripping or running water when everything is turned off.
- Check if there are any dripping taps.
- Try a few drops of food colouring in the toilet cistern. Colour in the bowl without flushing means a leak.



Appliances

- Look behind dishwashers and washing machines.
- Check for dampness, mould, or pooling water.



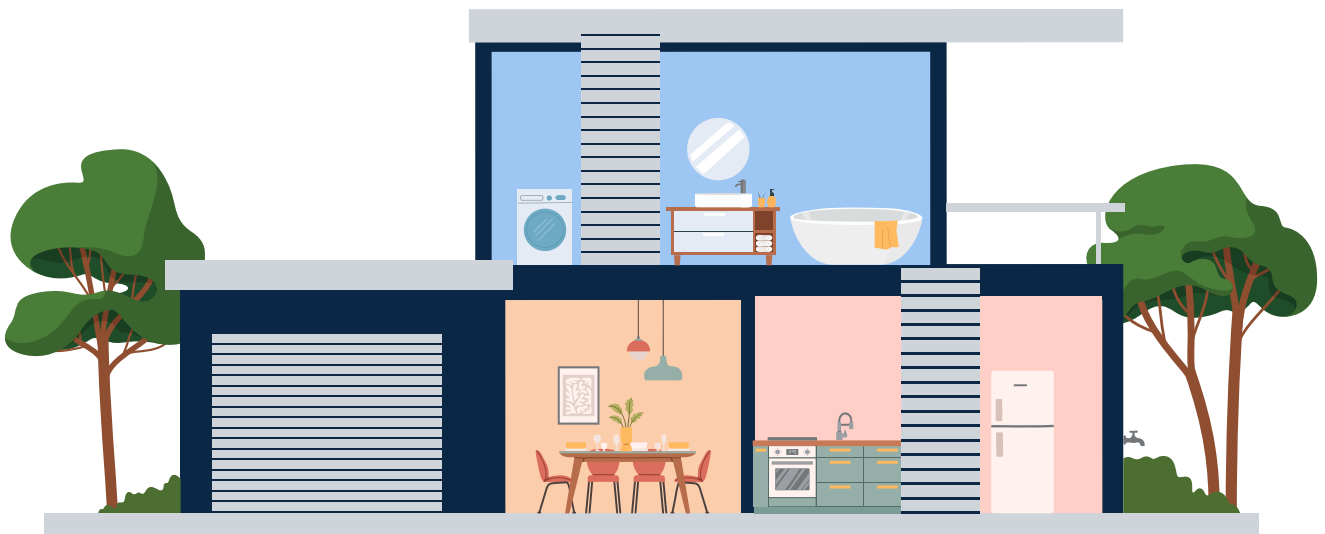
Outdoors

- Look for wet patches on the lawn or in the garden in dry weather.
- Check paved areas, such as driveways, for cracking, rising up or slumping.



Hot water

- Check the hot-water cylinder relief valve isn't constantly dripping.
- Look for water near overflow or drain points.
