

**Directions/Panel Minute 4**  
**LUC24/4848583**  
**Application by New Plymouth Pistol Club Inc**  
**228 De Havilland Drive/1206 Devon Road (State Highway 3)**

- 1) In Minute 3, we outlined the further directions the Panel had in mind for subsequent steps in the hearing process.
- 2) Following receipt of the further input we gave leave for Mr Phillips, Puketapu Hapū and Messrs Ellerton and Robinson to produce, we confirm our direction that Mr Edwards, Mr C Robinson and Ms Williams conference on conditions and file a Joint Witness Statement by 5 pm on Tuesday, 2 June.
- 3) Mr Robinson has indicated that while he can produce the comparison with other cases he suggested during the hearing, he would welcome the input of Mr Edwards and Ms Williams. We consider that the table he discusses at paragraph [16] of his addendum would be helpful and we request that the three planners collaborate on its contents in order that it might form part of their Joint Witness Statement.
- 4) We request that the three planners address one specific condition option. The applicant previously proposed a three day respite before major events. That proposal was withdrawn because of the need for competitors to be able to shoot before an event. The Panel requests that the planners consider, as an alternative option, the potential for a three day respite period after such events. The applicant may also wish to address that possibility in its reply.
- 5) We also confirm our direction that Mr C Robinson has leave to provide any additional comments he has arising from the Puketapu Hapū response by 5pm on 2 June.
- 6) Lastly, we confirm that the applicant's reply is to be filed by 5pm on 16 June.
