In 1977 the land was vested in the Inglewood Borough Council as reserve upon subdivision.

There are currently no improvements on this reserve.

Uses and activities

This reserve is suitable for child's play and picnicking.

- This reserve will be maintained as an open space area suitable for child's play and casual recreation.
- This reserve has been identified as a possible site to relocate the playground from William Franklyn Park to; if it was determined that William Franklyn Park was not suitable as a future playground location due to ongoing drainage problems.

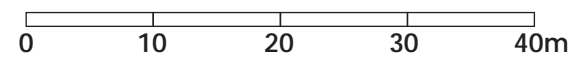
