I WISH TO REGISTER MY OBJECTION TO THIS APPLICATION FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

I am one of the notified neighbours to the proposed development at 1 Dawson Street, New Plymouth and there are a number of strong objections I have in regards to the proposed extension and addition of a roof top apartment with swimming poo - Resource Application number LUC20/47660.

I am aware that the existing structure already exceeds the stipulated height restriction and accordingly, this application would exceed this height restriction substantially more

This would block a wide section of my view shaft towards the Port and would be even more detrimental for owners who live on lower levels of our Apartment complex and on other properties in close proximity to 1 Dawson Street.

It is my understanding that a proposed residential development would be permitted <u>except</u> where it would adversely affect the amenities of any existing residential property, taking into consideration issues such as height, landscaping, and physical considerations e.g. sunlight, shading, view shaft etc. It is also my understanding that residential development should complement and respect the character and amenity of neighbouring properties, ensuring adequate privacy for the occupants of the building and of adjacent residential properties.

I strongly believe that this proposed extension is a direct contravention of these policies. It does not respect local context or, in particular, the scale and proportions of surrounding buildings and it would be entirely detrimental to the local environment. The proposed height would demonstrably harm the amenities enjoyed by nearby residents, in particular, privacy, sun, view shaft and serious shading.

I have serious concerns about the adverse effect this would have on a large number of neighbours. For example, this proposal makes no consideration for the living standards of existing residents of adjoining and nearby properties.

The submission states shading would be minimal however this is far from correct as natural light would be substantially reduced if this massive extension was to be permitted. The proposed extension is also of such height that several outdoor balcony areas would be severely overlooked from the windows of this extension, resulting in a serious invasion of privacy. It would have a dominating impact on many residents.

The proposed planting of trees, would further reduce the view shaft for many of us in the Richmond Estate as well as for adjacent properties on the mountain side and on the Port side of Dawson Street.

The application states repeatedly that the impact will be insignificant to neighbouring properties. I strongly disagree. I consider this proposed extension to be a direct contravention of a commitment to protect and enhance the value of the urban area as a whole.

In conclusion, I request that the application as submitted, be denied.
