## **Close of Hearing**

The hearing was adjourned at the completion of the last hearing day on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> October 2018 pending receipt four items of information. These items have now all been provided, being:

- A response from Mr Doherty, on behalf of the New Plymouth District Council, to answer two
  questions arising from his supplementary evidence dated 19<sup>th</sup> October 2018 (response
  received on 26 October 2019);
- 2. A response from Dr Drinan, on behalf of the Director General of Conservation, regarding the area of riparian planting to be provided as a compensation measure (response received on 29 October 2018);
- Legal advice from Counsel, on behalf of the New Plymouth District Council, as requested by Minute 6 on the status of iwi authorities regarding Ngā Hapū o Poutama (advice received 25<sup>th</sup> October 2018); and
- 4. Closing submissions from Counsel on behalf of the New Zealand Transport Agency (submissions received on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2018).

Having considered those items I am now satisfied that I have enough information on which to make a decision. On that basis, I declare the hearing closed as of today, Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2018.

## **Decision Timeframe**

At the end of the last hearing day on 24<sup>th</sup> October 2018 I indicated that I would aim to release a decision before the end of November. That is still the case and I will seek to issue my decision and recommendation to the Minister on, or before, Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2018.
