Attach additional pages if required. 1. The Proposed building height will exceed the ODP by 13 metres and the PDP by 8 metres. I oppose the breach of height restrictions contained in the NPDC district plan. 2. The proposed building height of 25 Metres will adversely affect 3 significant view shafts specified in the ODP and PDP both from seaward and to seaward. I oppose the application as it will adversely affect the public amenity value of views linking land to sea. 3. I oppose the removal of the protected tree: a) its a protected tree b) the removal of the Protected tree will adverely affect a stonewall heritage site which is part of colonial history, being the remnants of a railway embankment built in the 1880's 4. Heritage context: I oppose the application as its height of 25 Metres is in no way aligned with the "Heritage Character Area" Referenced exstensively in the PDP "Building Design Guide" page 8 "Although there are taller buildings within the heritage character area, the predominant pattern is of 2 storey buildings built to the street edge. This contributes to a well defined and generally consistent streetscape character that is most pronounced along Devon Street. THE CITY AND TOWN CENTRE DESIGN GUIDE HELPS TO ENSURE THAT NEW DEVELOPMENT IN THE HERITAGE CHARACTER AREA DOES NOT COMPROMISE THE INDIVIDUAL VALUE OF THE HERITAGE BUILDINGS OR THE INTEGRITY OF THE PRECINCTS STREET SCAPE AND SETTING" 5. I oppose the application as the shade created by the breach of building height will significantly cast shade over the Victor Davies reserve and adversely affect the public amenity value of that area.
