



# Promote Be Seen! Tīaho Mai! and be in to win!



Our school is participating in *Be Seen! Tīaho Mai!* (meaning *shine forth*) to encourage students to make sure they are easily seen by other road users as they travel to and from school. Here are ways your whānau can get involved.

## Talk about these messages at home

### 1. Be seen *Tīaho mai*

Wear bright colours and use bike lights when out walking and riding. It could be the difference in being seen by others, or not.

### 2. Look twice *Titiro, titiro anō*

When you scan the road quickly, your brain only picks up what it is expecting to see. Take a second look.

### 3. Slow down *Whakapōturi* and share the road

Show courtesy and respect to all road users.

### 4. Make good decisions *Kōwhiria te whiringa pai*

When crossing the road. Never assume you have been seen.
