

## UPCOMING ROAD WORKS

### SH45 Devon Street West: 28 March-5 April

Kia ora,

Downer, on behalf of NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi (NZTA) and the New Plymouth District Council (NPDC), will undertake repairs at SH45 Devon Street West between Mt Edgecumbe Street and Belt Road from Saturday 28 March for approximately 6 nights, and 3 days, weather permitting.

The work involves changing out the concrete cycle lane separators for an alternative, rebuilding a section of the road with asphalt, and resurfacing a second section with MicroPave; and will be completed under a series of nighttime closures, and daytime contraflow (two way) traffic controls.

#### **Stage 1 - NIGHT CLOSURES - SH45 Devon St West between Mt Edgecumbe St and Belt Rd: 28 March-2 April**

- Crews will remove the existing cycle lane separators between Mt Edgecumbe St and Belt Rd and rebuild the road with asphalt between Belt and Cutfield roads.
- **To complete this work as safely and efficiently as possible, SH45 Devon St West between Mt Edgecumbe and Morley streets, and between Morley St and Belt Rd, will be CLOSED at each night between 7pm and 6am.**
  - The closure sites are shown in red on the attached map.
  - **The Morley St intersection will remain open, however access to/from both sides of Devon St West will be closed during working hours.**
- Please plan ahead and take alternative routes where possible.
- Outside of working hours (6am-7pm) the road will be open; however, a temporary speed limit will remain in place until the work is complete.
- Pedestrian and property access within the site will be maintained. If you need to travel and require assistance, please speak with one of our onsite crew.

#### **Stage 2 - DAY WORKS - SH45 Devon St West between Cutfield Rd & Mt Edgecumbe St: 3-5 April**

- Crews will MicroPave Devon St West between Cutfield Rd and Mt Edgecumbe St from 3-5 April from 7am to 7pm each day. The site is shown in blue on the attached map.
- The site will be run under contraflow (two-way) traffic controls with minimal delays.
  - **During working hours, access to/from the northern sides of Morley St and Devon St West will be closed.**
  - **A short section of the northern side of Devon St West will also be closed during this work.**
- Please plan ahead and take alternative routes where possible.
- Outside of working hours (7pm-7am) all roads will remain open; however, a temporary speed limit will remain in place until the work is complete.
- MicroPave is a specialist treatment designed to improve the road surface and reduce noise from traffic.
- This treatment needs to be completed during the day as it requires warmer, drier conditions to set.

**In the case of unsuitable weather, this project will be rescheduled to take place 7-17 April.**

After this work is complete, crews will then install new cycle lane separators over 4-5 days under contraflow (two-way) traffic controls with no access to side roads impacted.


