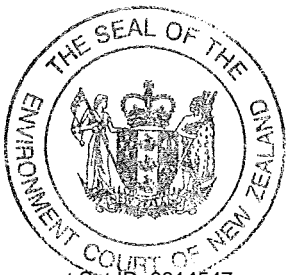

**Introduction**

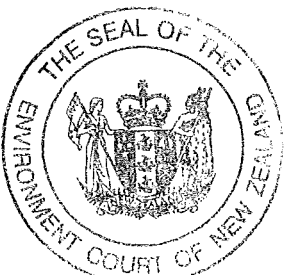
[1] On 9 June 2020 the Court issued an interim decision<sup>1</sup> allowing the appeal relating to a review of the conditions of the 2001 land use consent PD 201041 (**2001 consent**), which authorises the operation of the Gisborne Pistol Club Incorporated at 150 Gaddums Hills Road, Kaiti. The 2001 consent was amended by the substitution of draft conditions set out in Appendix 1 of the interim decision.

[2] The Court granted leave for the parties to comment on limited aspects of the draft conditions by way of joint memorandum no later than 14 July 2020. No memorandum was received.

[3] As such, the conditions as outlined in the interim decision are confirmed.
