Hi Laura,

As discussed on the phone the vehicle access to lot 2 cannot be made next to the crossing for lot 5 as it will not have safe sight visibility to the south due to the Crest in the road (currently it only has approx. 80m visibility to the south ). The new crossings for lots 2 and 3 will need to be close to the brow of the hill so that they can achieve safe visibility north and south. The minimum safe sight visibility for a 100km/h environment is 160m. Access to lot 1 can be done at time of BC for the new dwelling but will most likely be located toward the south of the lot so it gets safe visibility to the intersection to the north.
